1. Verbal Ability (25 Questions × 1 mark = 25 Marks)

Verbal ability is test designed to check the skills of the students in the field of word power to express ideas using words. To score in verbal ability, one should improve vocabulary and grammatical skills. Verbal ability covers grammar, vocabulary, reading comprehension, sentence correction, synonyms, antonyms, idioms, phrases etc. Verbal Ability comprises 25 out of 100 Marks in the syllabus in Rajarshi Janak University Central Management Admission Test (RJU-CMAT).

2. Quantitative Ability (25 Questions × 1 mark = 25 Marks)

Quantitative aptitude tests student's ability to solve mathematical problem critically with the use of logical and analytical skills. Quantity ability covers HCF and LCF, Ratio and Proportion, Profit and loss, Partnership, Percentage, permutation and combination, Number Theory, Data comparison, Data interpretation, Indices, Sequence and series, Measurement of central tendency and dispersion, Probability etc. Quantitative Ability Section comprises 25 out of 100 Marks in the syllabus in Rajarshi Janak University Central Management Admission Test (RJU-CMAT).

3. Logical Reasoning (25 Questions × 1 mark = 25 Marks)

Logical reasoning section evaluates the candidate's skill in solving problems using logic rather just memorizing facts. In Rajarshi Janak University Central Management Admission Test (RJU-CMAT), logical reasoning comprises 25 out of 100 Marks in the syllabus.

4. General Awareness (25 Questions × 1 mark = 25 Marks)

General Awareness covers currents affairs (Business, Politics, Banking, Economy, Sports, Science & Literature, various Management Theories, and Current Fact). In Rajarshi Janak University Central Management Admission Test (RJU-CMAT), general awareness comprises 25 out of 100 Marks in the syllabus.
