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

Guidelines for Paper Submission

Authors are requested to adhere to the following guidelines before submitting their papers.

1. Only original papers which have unpublished and adhere to the theme and subthemes of Seminar, will be accepted.
2. For English, Use Times New Roman & Kruti dev font style for hindi (For the entire manuscript with specific font sizes for different parts and headings of the paper (as given below).
3. Word limit for the full paper: 2500 to 3000 words (Maximum 10 to 12 Pages).
4. Title of the Paper: Font 14, Center text and Bold.
5. Abstract: Font 12, Italics, word limit-around 200 words.
6. Key words: 5 to 7.
7. All headings with font size 13 in bold.
8. References and Bibliography: APA 7th edition format.
9. Diagrams/graphs/figures: Properly placed and cited in the text with figure labels/description at the bottom of the diagram/graphs/figures/sketches etc.
10. Name of the contributor(s), designation, institutional affiliation, mobile number, and email-id must be given properly, preferably on the first sheet of the paper.
11. Copyright issues must be taken care of. The manuscript must not have plagiarism more than 10% (as per UGC Guidelines).
